1	“Creative Problem Solving”	to use this method, the beginning of the story is read and the end is given to the students;	80%
2	“Merry Riddles”	to learn words they are unfamiliar with and find the answer to a riddle that is an important part of teaching English to students	80%
3	“Quick answers”	to help increasing the effectiveness of the lesson;	95%

4	“Warm-up exercises”	to use various games in the classroom to engage students in the lesson	90%
5	“Pantomime”	to used in a class where very difficult topics need to be explained, or when students are tired of writing exercises	70%
6	“A chain story”	to helps developing of the students' oral skills;	80%
7	“Acting character”	To use in all types of lessons. Professionals such as Interpreter, Translator, Writer, and Poet can participate in the class and talk to students;	60%
